About the Choir

The Choir was founded on 2 January 1923 at Westbourne Street Methodist Church and performed its first concert there less than five weeks later – the forerunner of many such concerts around the town. The objective is to create a relaxed and friendly atmosphere, whilst maintaining the highest musical standards. Every year the Choir helps to raise money for national and local charities and perform in support of numerous local organisations, in venues ranging from local churches, village halls, theatres and in the open air! Most concerts are performed in Buckinghamshire and the surrounding counties of Berkshire, Oxfordshire, Hertfordshire and Middlesex but the Choir has performed further afield – in recent years it has performed at the Millennium Concert in Wells Cathedral, the Albert Hall in London as a guest English Choir in the London Welsh Festival of Male Choirs, the International Variety Club's Award Dinner in the London Guildhall, Magdalen College in Oxford and the Cornwall International Male Voice Choral Festival.

About being a Friend
